

# CIVILIAN FINGERPRINTING

**Effective June 1, 2006, the Beavercreek Police Department will no longer be able to fingerprint individuals for civilian background checks.** We do not have the equipment which is necessary for electronic fingerprint submission.

The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation will no longer be accepting ink rolled fingerprint cards for Ohio background checks. They offer WebCheck, which is an Internet-based program for civilian background checks. The program reduces the return rate to as little as several hours.
